(Sept meeting)

The first meeting of the new year was held on Monday eve. Aug 31st in the Odd Fellows' Hall, the following members being present, Mrs. James Brown in the Chair, Shaw. Hunter. Randle. Snowden. Rowbottom. Beckley. Beech. Priestley. Kenyon. Bulman. Dailey. Reilly. Nelson, Weigle & Powers.

The members of the Hospital Board having been invited to be present, the following attended Messrs. Booth, Cunningham, Humming and Shaw.

The minutes of previous meetings were read and approved on motion by Mrs Randle. Seconded by Mrs Dailey.

Two bills were presented and ordered paid. moved by Mr Weigle 2nd by Mrs Beckley.

The principal business of the evening was the discussion on how we are to use our money in the future, and it was moved by Mrs Randle seconded by Mrs Weigle that

we invest our money, in first-mortgage which will bring 8% instead of 3% from the Bank, and keep it as a sinking fund for a new Hospital. the Board in the mean time to pay for Hospital supplies, carried. Mrs Priestly moved seconded by Mrs Randle that the Officers be a Committee in conjunction with Mr Shaw to attend to the business of investing money, carried. The Treasurer reported some \$1100.00 in Bank.

Mrs Powers moved seconded by Mr Shaw that the trying Committee for the new year be the President - Mrs Wight & Mrs Randle, Carried. ~~The~~ It being necessary to change the By-Laws to fit new conditions the Pres. appointed - Mrs Randle. Mrs Hunt & Mrs Beckley a Committee to attend to this business. The matter of changing the day of meeting, in order not to conflict with the Inaccabee meeting, was discussed, but no definite step taken.
